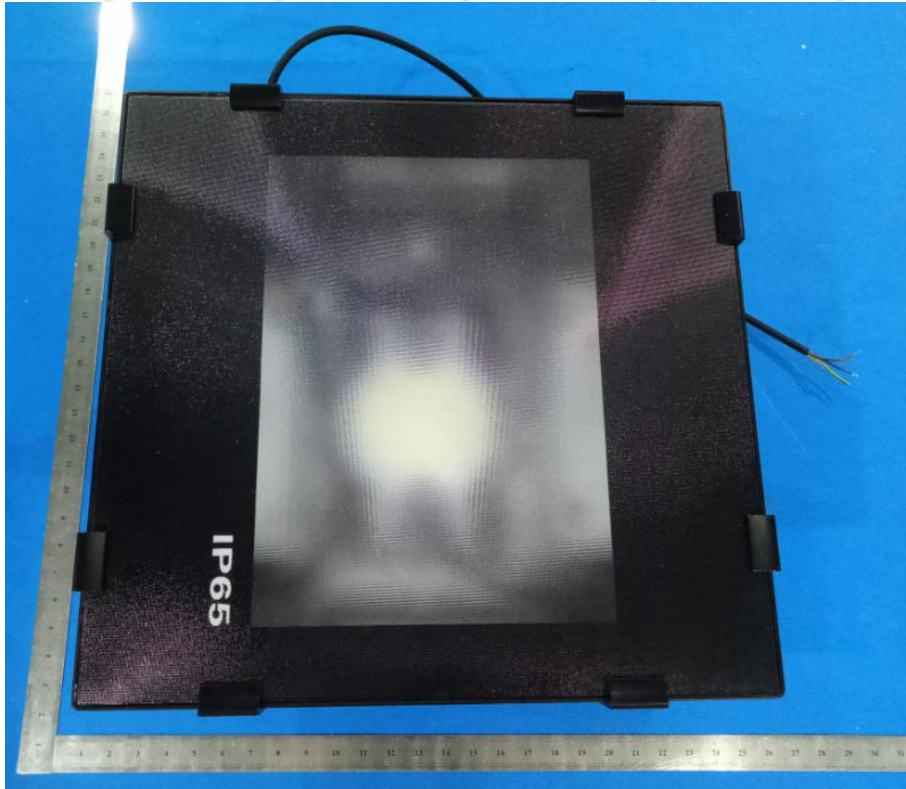


Fig.1 – General view

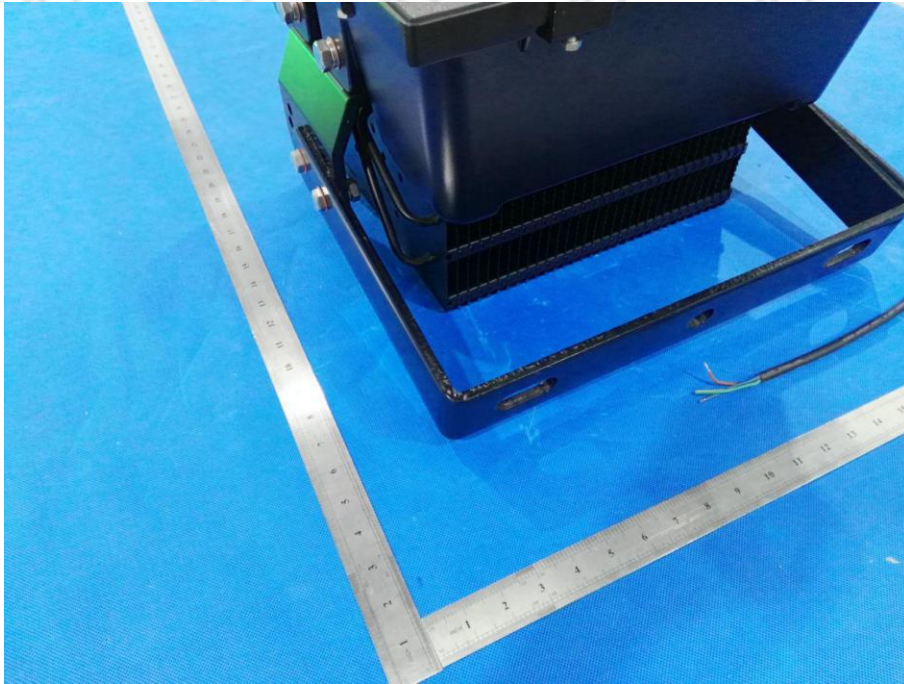


Fig.3 –General view

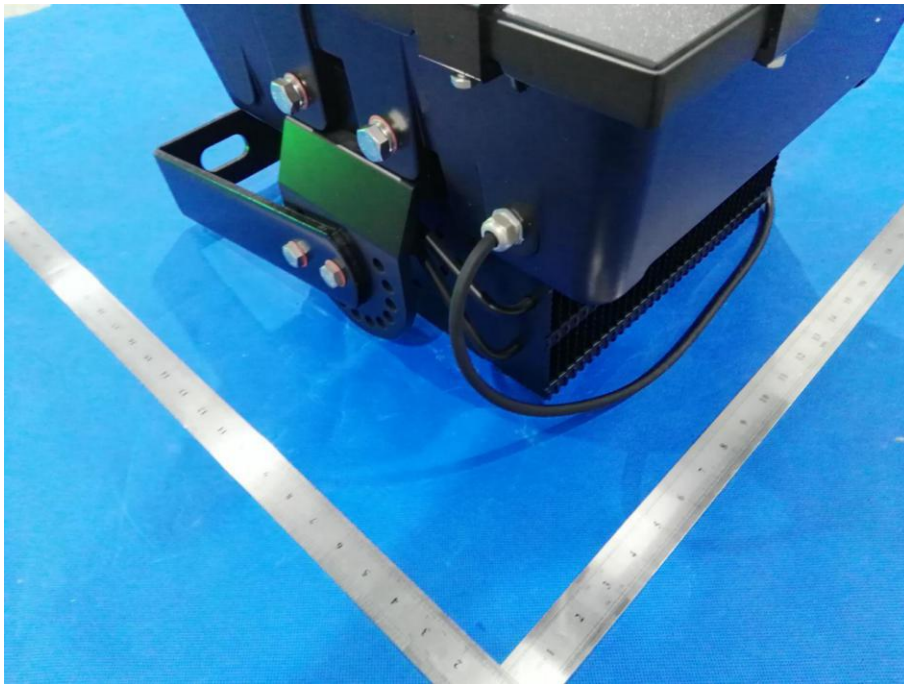


Fig.3 –General view

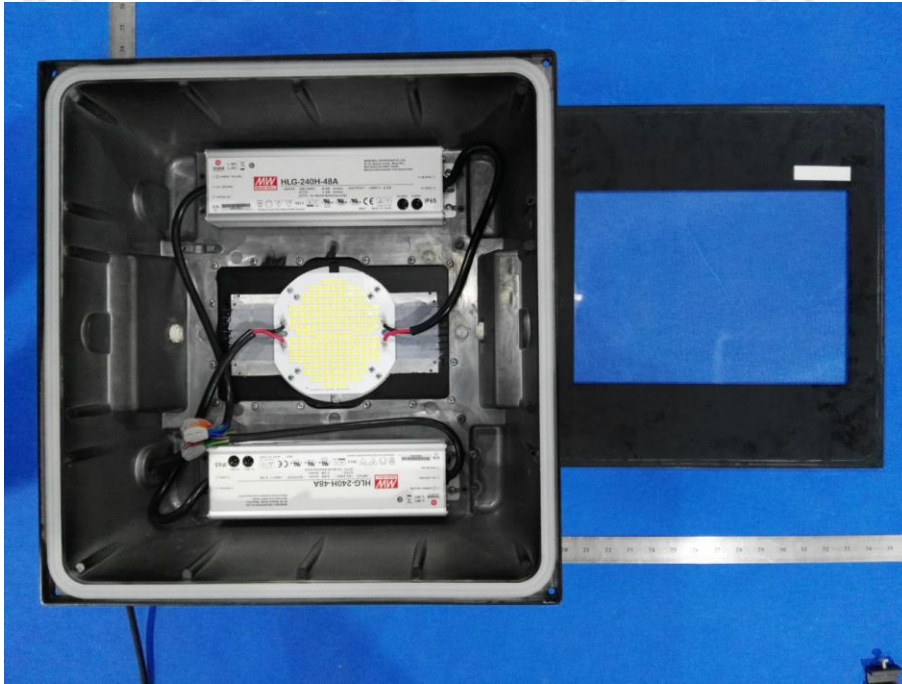


Fig.5 – Inner view

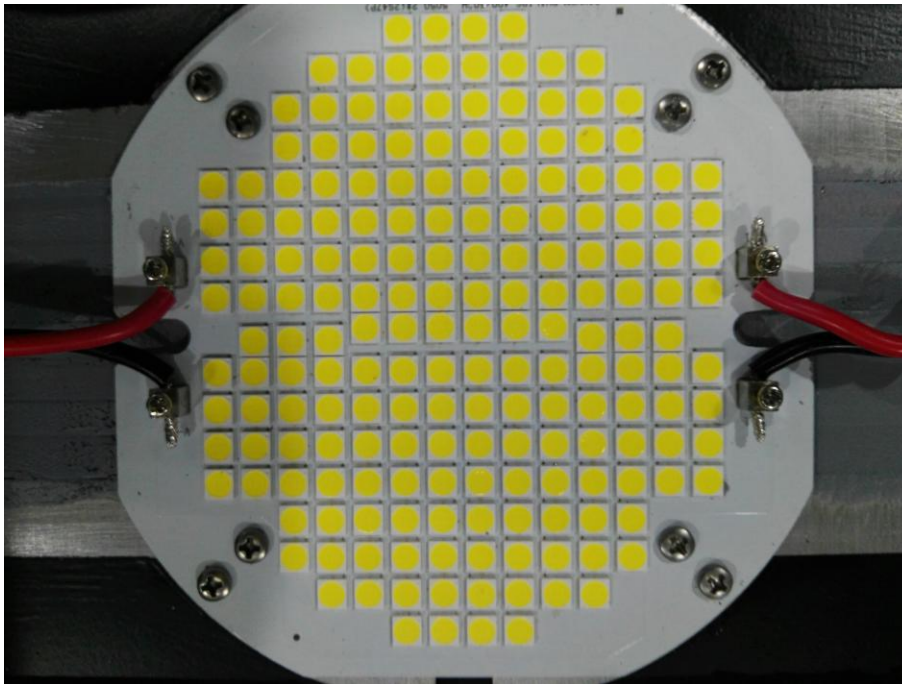


Fig.6 – Inner view
